

Carlingford

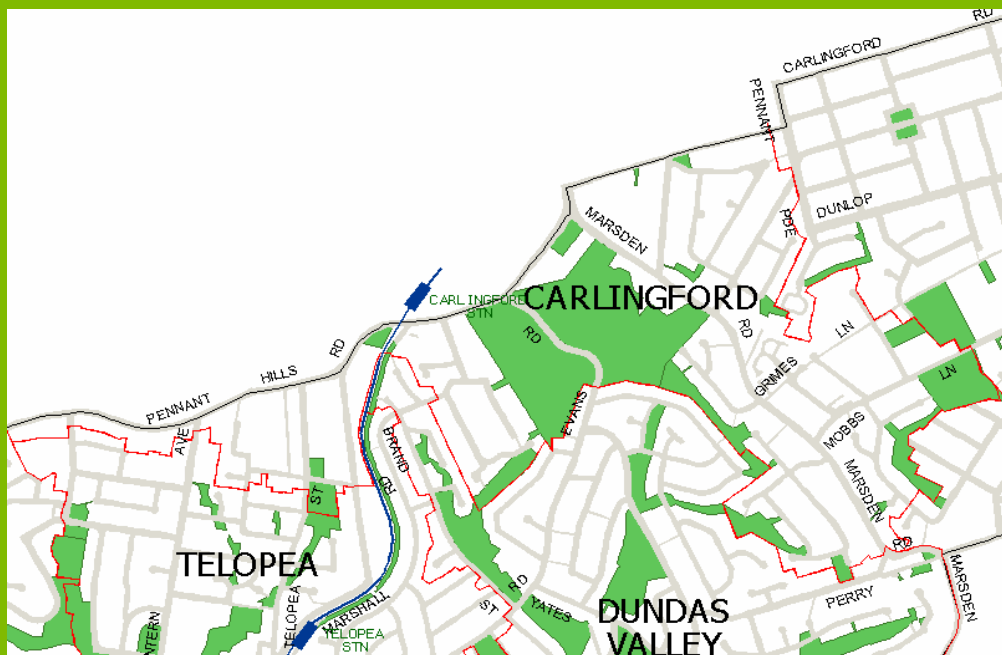


First settled in the late 18th century and early 19th century, Carlingford overlooks the Dundas and Parramatta River Valleys about 20 minutes drive from Parramatta's CBD. It became a significant fruit orcharding community. By the late 1950s, however, Carlingford had become a predominantly residential area centred around the railway station.

With a landscape of gentle slopes leading from the Pennant Hills and Midson Road ridges, it contains substantial areas of natural bushland and domestic gardens which display large numbers of established native and ornamental trees.

The main service centre for the suburb is the Carlingford Court Centre with a smaller centre connected to the railway station.

Mobbs Hill Lookout, located on the highest point in Parramatta's LGA, is a feature of the area with broad views to the south over the Parramatta River, CBD and Olympic Park precinct.

Where We Are Heading

Local neighbourhoods change by age and culture over time. This requires that we think about different housing and transport options, as well as employment and recreational opportunities for the younger residents.

We will continue working with Baulkham Hills and Hornsby Shire Councils to plan for, and recognise opportunities to jointly address environmental and other planning issues, such as population densities around Carlingford Station and the creation of a town centre.

Service improvements and station upgrades along the Carlingford to Clyde Rail Line will require lobbying to ensure any future populations are well serviced by public transport.

Traffic movements throughout local streets may need calming to maintain safe, quality neighbourhoods.

Maintain and improve pedestrian and cycling routes throughout the neighbourhoods to link Carlingford Court and other smaller shopping centres to local services, facilities and households.
